

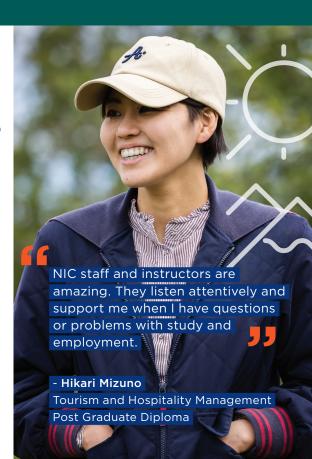

NIC's digital design and development post graduate programs provide focused, industry-relevant training with the opportunity to collaborate with a diverse team of designers, developers and employers in the region. The programs include extended, six-credit capstone projects where you'll produce substantial digital products and manage all stages of the development life cycle: ideation, prototyping, testing, coding, quality assurance, deployment and launch.

Graduates are hired as software engineers and designers, computer programmers, interactive media developers, web/graphic designers and developers, graphic illustrators, UI/UX specialists and multimedia specialists.

Web development stream

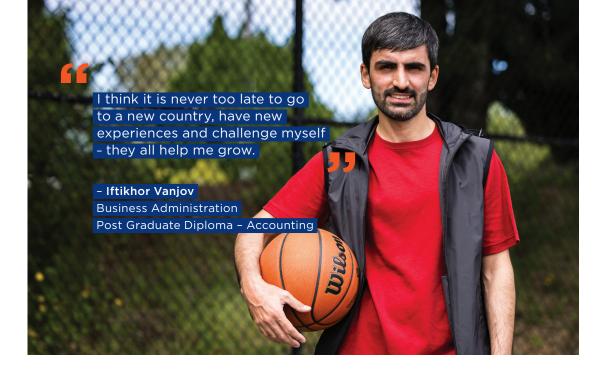
The web development stream provides training for 'front-end' (coding static and dynamic websites), 'back-end' (accessing server-side databases) and web application development (coding a software application that runs on a browser like Google Chrome). This is a great option for students with backgrounds in fine arts, design or marketing.

Mobile application development stream

The mobile application development stream provides training to code software applications on both Android and iOS mobile devices. Students with backgrounds in IT, software engineering, computer science, computer applications will thrive in this stream.

NIC's tourism and hospitality programs focus on the business skills needed for supervisors and managers in this exciting and fast-paced industry. You'll develop strong accounting, marketing, events management, communication and leadership skills, enabling you to compete effectively for rewarding positions in the global tourism industry.

Career possibilities include: tourism customer service representative, restaurant and food service managers, accommodation service managers, conference and event planners, accommodation, travel, tourism and related services supervisors, front desk supervisor, hotel front desk clerks, housekeeping supervisor, restaurant and food services, hotel front desk managament, tourism and travel services and much more.

In your first year, you'll develop your management skills through a combination of theory-based and applied courses. Principles of accounting and marketing are quickly put into practice as you hone your skills, on-campus at the Third Course Bistro and through the creation of special events.

Depending on your professional objectives, you will choose a specialty in year two — hospitality or tourism — and complete a four-month internship with employers like Old House Hotel and Spa, Kingfisher Oceanside Resort and Spa, Crown Isle Resort and Golf Community, Naturally Pacific Resort (Campbell River), Fairmont Hotels, Marriott Hotels, Westerly Hotel, WestJet and Air Canada.

Do I need an agent?

If you are from India, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Philippines, Nepal, Sri Lanka or Nigeria, you are required to work with an NIC authorized agent. To find an agent, visit international.nic.bc.ca

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

General admission requirements for international applicants:

- A passport that is valid until the end of your scheduled program
- Completion of a three or four-year degree (include transcripts and graduation diploma) from an accredited post-secondary institution with minimum GPA of 60%
- IELTS 6.0 or equivalent. Students with a band score of Academic IELTS 5.5 will be required to take ENG 104 in the first semester. See our website for more information
- Graduates of recognized degree programs (three or four years in length) from an accredited post-secondary institution where English was the medium of instruction (and where English is an official language of the country) are also accepted as meeting the English language requirement. For the full list of countries, visit nic.bc.ca/international

Accounting requirements:

Students entering into Business Administration Post Graduate Diploma - Accounting option must have completed Grade 11 math or higher, along with a financial accounting course at postsecondary level.

The students who do not meet financial accounting requirements may opt to enter the management option for the first term and take the required financial accounting course first. They may then transition to the accounting option in the second term.

Digital Design and Development requirements:

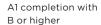
