### Course Information:

Learn the skills to create a hammered link bracelet out of sterling silver wire. You will learn and practice piercing, filing, sanding, fabrication and soldering, and then finish off your jewellery piece by learning different polishing techniques. Create your own design or choose one of the sample designs to work from. This project is for all levels and the technique can be used to create other projects in the future with very little tools and equipment. Note: Materials are provided and included in the price.

### Supplies to Bring from Home:

- Safety glasses (mandatory)
- Reading glasses or magnification such as an optivisor if needed.
- Face dust mask (N95 rating).
- Old soft cloth (flannel preferred) or hand towel.
- Small ball peen hammer (if you already have one).
- Any small pliers used for jewellery (no teeth) if you have them.
- Small tool box or container for your tools.
- Tie backs for long hair.
- Shop apron (if you have one).
- Writing paper or sketch book and pencil/pen.
- Sharpie permanent ink fine tip pen.
- Any pictures of designs that inspire you.
