Silver Jewellery Express II

In this fast-paced and exciting workshop, a continuation of Silver Jewellery Express I, you will be creating two more sterling silver projects. Learn new techniques such as advanced fabrication and soldering, creating a tube setting for a ring and setting the stone with accuracy. We will be adding texture by introducing surface ornamentation techniques using our studio stamps and hammers, fusing with metal, and coloring with patinas. Advance your skills and reignite your creative process in a creative group atmosphere. This course is designed for those who have taken Silver Jewellery Express I or an equivalent course.

Note:

This course is designed for those who have taken *Silver Jewellery Express I (GENI 1204)* or an equivalent beginner jewellery workshop. If you have taken the longer *Silver Jewellery Making – Beginners course (GENI 1205)*, the follow-up course *Silver Jewellery Making-Beyond Basics (GENI 1206)* is recommended instead. GENI 1206 is also recommended for those who complete this Express II course, to gain even more skills!

Supply Fee:

Your course fee includes supplies you will receive in class to complete your projects.

Supplies and Materials required (to bring from home):

- Safety glasses (mandatory)
- Reading glasses or magnification such as an optivisor if needed.
- Face dust mask (N95 rating mandatory)
- Old soft cloth (flannel preferred) or hand towel.
- Small ball peen hammer (if you already have one).
- Any small pliers used for jewellery (no teeth) if you have them.
- Small tool box or container for your tools.
- Shop apron (if you have one).
- Writing paper or sketch book and pencil/pen.
- Sharpie permanent ink fine tip pen.
- Any pictures of designs that inspire you.

Bring a bagged lunch and beverage as a short break will be taken.

Please wear close-toed shoes (no sandals) for safety and bring something to tie long hair back.
