General Supply List

Required Items for Class

- Safety glasses (mandatory)
- Face dust mask (N95 rating)

Recommended Items to Bring (Optional)

- Small sketch book and pencil.
- A pair of scissors.
- Old soft cloth, small hand towel.
- Any small smooth jaw pliers you may have: chain nose, flat nose and round nose.
- Small wire cutters, flush end or diagonal.
- Small container with tight fitting lid for metal scrap and filings.
- Small tool or tackle box to keep your tools in for class.
- Any other small tools you may have if you think they may be of use.

Important Things to Remember

- The Metal Jewellery Workshops are all offered at the Campbell River Campus (1685 S. Dogwood Street), in room D244 (which is at the end of the D-Wing hallway)
- Parking is free on campus—the closest lot to the studio is the gravel lot on your right, when you enter from Dogwood Street.
- Please bring a bagged lunch and beverage as a short break will be taken. The college cafeteria and coffee shop is not open on weekends, unfortunately.
- Wear appropriate clothing or bring shop apron to protect your clothes.
- For safety reasons please wear closed-toe shoes (no sandals).
